Important notes regarding cost-share:

- Cost-share rates are \$15/acre for winter-hardy cover crops or \$10/acre for winterkill cover crops. First-time cover crop users are eligible for an additional \$5/acre.
- Seeding methods, rates, and deadlines for all cover crops must follow the Cover Crop Seeding Guidelines in order to receive payment.
- Applicants must provide a W-9 Form, IDALS Cover Crop Seeding Verification Form, Maintenance Agreement, and a seed invoice for applications to be considered complete.
- Homegrown seed **must** be tested for germ & purity.
- Applications must be received prior to cover crop seeding!
- Receipt of cost-share funds from multiple State or Federal programs is not allowed. Examples include, but are
 not limited to, Crop Insurance Reduction Programs, Water Quality Initiative Statewide, EQIP, and Soil and Water
 Outcomes Fund.
